COMPETITION AGREEMENT 2024-25

To be completed by ALL members wishing to compete in senior carnivals 24-25 season

As a member of Bribie Island Surf Life Saving Club, you are expected to carry out your membership requirements. These are:

1. Meet all your patrolling requirements. Members 14 and above (under 15's up), you **must do** or have a **swap** for **all patrols**, including those that fall on carnival days.
2. Anyone wishing to compete must complete a **minimum of 25 patrol hours** during the competition season. This requirement includes Long Service, Life Members and Active Reserves, competing in Masters, Seniors and Youth carnivals.
3. **Attend** the compulsory club **fund raising** events door to door collections. It is the club expectation that you will participate for a minimum of 4 hours and collect the minimum target to be eligible to have your nomination fees paid by the club.
4. Participate in any fundraising your team may decide upon.

These duties are vital to the functioning of an efficient club. As repayment for you fulfilling your membership requirements, the club will pay for your nominations to carnivals throughout the season (Excluding World Championships). It is expected that all members representing the club in competition ensure that the proud tradition and spirit of the club is maintained. To ensure this happens, all competitors must fulfil the following competition requirements to compete for the club.

Any member that misses any patrols without arranging a swap may be excluded from competition and will be required to pay their own nomination fees.

1. Fulfil the four membership requirements outlined above.
2. Be involved in formal, structured training for you chosen event.
3. Complete and submit a training log to the club, as overleaf. (This aids insurance cover if you are injured during training and/or competition.)
4. Always give 100% in competition.
5. Compete in all events you have nominated yourself in.

Not meeting any of these requirements may lead to a member being disqualified from competition, and competitors may need to repay the club for the carnival nomination fees. Despite being a small club, we've achieved significant success in competition. While we aren't wealthy, we are committed to supporting our members in their competitive efforts, as long as they fulfill their obligations to the club.
