COURSE	PREREQUISITES
Observers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Financial Club Member (with Blue Card over 18 years)Minimum of 13 years of age on the date of final assessment
Surf Rescue Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">be at least 13 years of age on the date of final assessmentcomplete an unaided swim, with an overarm stroke of 200 metres in five (5) minutes or less, in a swimming pool of not less than 25 metres. This will be observed prior to any training or assessment activities. Pool swim can be observed by a qualified Training Officer Bronze Medallion, Assessor Bronze Medallion or ASCTA/AUSTSWIM Swim Coach. Evidence of the pool swim (and the qualification of the person observing the poolswim if outside of SLSQ) must be provided to the Trainer on the appropriate form/s.
Bronze Medallion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">be a financial member of an SLS club (with Blue Card over 18 years)be at least 15 years of age on the final assessment datecomplete an unaided swim of 400 m in 9 minutes or less in a swimming pool of not less than 25 m, which will be observed prior to you undertaking any training or assessment activities. Evidence of this must be provided to the assessor prior to commencement of the assessment for this qualification/SLSA award.
